## General Event

Time: 5:00 Doors Open

Ticket Cost: \$85/per person (includes before dinner appetizers, station style dinner, auction participation, dance competition, open dancing).

*\*These will be available for purchase via the website, or by contacting the CA office.*

*\*Dancers receive 2 dinner tickets. Tables are available for purchase if you have a group of 8 to accommodate. The more people you can bring to the event the more fun it is!!*

**Winning:** There are two winners for this event

1. People's Choice Winner – dancer who is able to raise the most amount of money.
2. Technical Winner – dancer who receives the best technical scores from the judges

**Attire:** General attire for this event is similar to what you would wear to a wedding.

*\*Dancers will need a dress or suit to wear before the competition.*

## Dance Lessons/Dancer Specifics

**Fred Astaire:** Fred Astaire Dance Studios are very high end studios that are located and owned across the US. Their dancers and staff compete at numerous events throughout the year. When it comes to ballroom they do it the best!

**How Fred Astaire Helps CA:** The owners at multiple Milwaukee area studios offer 7 free one-on-one lessons to each of our dancers! The instructor you take class with will be your partner for the main event. We could not do our event without them!

*\*Each dancer is responsible for contacting their Fred Astaire Studio and scheduling their lessons. Let the receptionist know that “you are a dancer for Citizen Advocates Gala” and you would like to set up times for your 7 free lessons.*

*\*If you want more practice time you can always purchase more classes through Fred Astaire directly.*

*\*If possible, participate in a dance party, it will give you a chance to practice your dance in front of a group of people.*

*\*Take someone with you to record your routine. This can be used to promote the event, help with fundraising and help you practice at home.*

**Attire for Lessons:** Business Casual style clothing is acceptable for lessons, street shoes are discouraged in the classrooms. Something comfortable you can dance in, tighter clothing is better, but most people don't go in sweats!

**Event Costumes/Hair/Make-up:** The ladies costumes for ballroom dancing are bright and colorful. Men can range from plain black and simple to bright based on the style selected.

-Ladies may be encouraged to wear false eyelashes. Buy a pair that is black, long and thick.

-There are also many dresses within the dance region that dancers may lend or rent. As you select your style work with your instructor to get this set. You can also order dresses online for a reasonable price. \*If the studio offers you a dress, ask the price before agreeing!
